

REQUEST FOR INFORMATION AND THE SUBMISSION OF AN INDICATIVE TENDER

LAN cabling systems

(hereinafter “RFI”)

1. Basic Information about the Customer

(hereinafter “LP”)

2. Objective of the RFI, Purpose

The subject of the contract will be to obtain preliminary information on the current market for LAN cabling systems.

In order to provide data network services to internal and external customers, Prague Airport has more than 150 MDF/IDF substations deployed in most of the buildings on the premises.

Most of the cable systems installed in these MDF/IDFs are from RiT Technologies, which is equipped with the AIM (Automated Infrastructure Management) system necessary for monitoring and efficient operation of the LAN cabling. RiT Technologies has since withdrawn from the European market.

Since 2018, LP has been deploying a cabling system from Reichle&De-Massari in combination with AIM from AT+C under the name ConnectionManager VM.7. This platform is capable of integrating cabling system components from other vendors.

LP's strategy is to have two cabling system suppliers capable of integration with ConnectionManager VM.7. Individual (new or refurbished) MDF/IDF substations will be equipped with the cabling system of one selected supplier. A minimum of 2 MDF/IDFs are reconstructed annually with an estimated volume of 2.5 Mio. CZK.

LP requests the approached entities to submit a written response or indicative bid as a second potential supplier of cabling system to this request as per the specification below.

3. Each Expected Indicative Tender Should Include

Each indicative tender should include the Annex 1.

4. Course of the RFI

Participation in the RFI is open. This RFI is published on LP's profile (<https://zakazky.prg.aero>), so all economic operators may participate.

Economic operators may send additional inquiries to LP through LP's profile, i.e. the E-ZAK electronic tool at <http://zakazky.prg.aero>. LP's anonymized answers to inquiries made by economic operators shall be published via the E-ZAK electronic tool.

Economic operators may send their indicative tenders through the E-ZAK electronic tool at <https://zakazky.prg.aero> or to martin.pernica@prg.aero by **11. 11. 2021 at 23:59 o'clock**. LP prefers that each indicative tender be entered as 1 PDF / ZIP file or similar. LP prefers that each indicative tender be prepared in either the Czech or English languages.

5. Final Provisions

Economic operators submit their indicative tenders for free; they cannot raise any claims against LP on the basis of their submitted tenders. Economic operators are not entitled to



any reimbursement of costs associated with the preparation of their indicative tenders. LP shall not return any received tenders.

Neither party may hand over, copy or otherwise physically or electronically provide information from an RFI to any third parties, except for their subcontractor.

This RFI is not a public competition for the best bid pursuant to Sections 1772 et seq. of Act No. 89/2012 Coll., the Civil Code, as amended, nor a public contract within the meaning of Act No. 134/2016 Coll., on public procurement, as amended (hereinafter "PPA"). No liabilities towards any economic operator shall arise for LP from the submitted tenders. LP reserves the right to change the terms and conditions of an RFI or to cancel an RFI without providing any reasons.

Economic operators acknowledge that this RFI serves LP only for market research and will in no way result in the acceptance of any tender or the conclusion of a contract. A contract for the requested subject of performance may possibly be subsequently announced either in accordance with the PPA or outside the PPA regime, and only if LP evaluates the announcement of the contract as effective in terms of the expected objectives. Therefore, no economic operators participating in this RFI are in any way entitled to conclude a contract with LP, nor do they acquire any rights or claims with respect to any future procurement procedures under the PPA with a similar subject matter of performance.

The governing law for all possible rights and obligations that may arise in connection with this RFI shall be the laws of the Czech Republic.
